Bachelor in Conservation

The Bachelor's programme in Conservation is fully modular and designed according to Swiss and European standards.

The full-time studies last three years and correspond to 180 ECTS credits. During the first two years students follow a coordinated curriculum defined by the four collaborating institutions and leading to commonly defined learning outcomes. In the third year students attend courses on a specific field of conservation at the institution responsible for it. Special conditions apply to the Abegg-Stiftung.

Master in Conservation-Restoration

The Master's programme in Conservation-Restoration prepares students for independent practice of the profession according to European ECCO and ENCoRE guidelines.

The full-time studies last two years and correspond to 120 ECTS credits. Each institution offers a Master's programme in the corresponding field of specialisation. Students develop conservation-restoration concepts on the basis of scientific, historical and technical knowledge.

The Master's programme develops intellectual and practical skills in a specialised field of conservation-restoration, requiring scientific and technical research.
